Mink/Mank Family This database project grew out of discussions at the Old Broad Bay Family History meeting in August of 1994 between myself and Joyce Ball Brown of Nobleboro. Joyce told me about a wonderful collection of Mink/Mank Family notes by Grace Blake Maxwell at the Skidompha Library in Damariscotta, ME, but that they were not well organized and somewhat hard to use and read. Since modern genealogy computer software makes the compilation of this type of material much more feasible, I agreed to take a look at what was involved. The following is the result of my first pass through the work.

Most of the pages of the notes were typed but there are many handwritten notes on each page that fill in and correct the typed information. What is reproduced in the following pages is my best interpretation of the handwriting and the sometimes hard to read typing. One must keep in mind that there may be errors in the original work and that I may have made some in transcribing. It is always important to go to the original sources themselves to verify the information in this work. Please let me know if there are any corrections or additional information.

I am not sure when these notes were compiled. The title page is undated. My sense is that most of this was gathered in the mid 1940's, but there are clippings and other notes into the 1980's and beyond. There are some duplicate pages and much of the material is covered on different pages, each with a slightly different slant. The first 16 pages are numbered. I numbered the rest of the pages so that accurate references could be made. Several contributors are listed, but it is unclear as to who contributed exactly what portions. "Some from Mrs. Lily" is on the title page. I have no further information as to who she was. Also Mrs. Esther Gross of Dover-Foxcroft, ME (p57) is mentioned as well as Edith Webster Mank. On page 21 the following is written: "Much of Edith Webster Mank's data was received from Sanford Bucklin of Warren, a Mank descendant. All that she has been able to check has proved accurate." Edith W. Mank died in 1945.

To fill out some missing information, I have added references from other sources as I have found them. Many thanks to Joyce Ball Brown for her suggestions and help. Even more thanks to the original compilers who had the foresight to help capture this valuable information for future generations.

Following are the first two generations of the descendants of Johann Georg Mink. In most early records the name was spelled Mink or Minck but pronounced like the English Mank. After the mid 1800's the spelling was shown as "Mank" in most records.

Johann Georg MINK1,2 immigrated in 1753. He was born in Altendietz, Rhein-Lohn, Rheinland-Pfelz, Germany. Was a book binder in "Alten Dietz". Came to Broad Bay in the ship Elizabeth in 1753. This family settled in the Manktown area of Waldoboro except for son Philip who r. adjacent to the Christian Hoffses homestead in South Waldoboro.

Gerdraut Katherine ZIEKLER3 was born in Altendietz, Rhein-Lohn, Rheinland-Pfelz, Germany. She died in , , ME. This name was also known as Ziegler. Johann Georg MINK and Gerdraut Katherine ZIEKLER had the following children:

I. Johann Philip MINK4,5 was born on 9 Feb 1749 in , , Germany. He died in 1806/7 in , , ME. Served in Revolutionary War. In his will, probated 24 June 1807, he mentions wife Susanna, and "my oldest daughter Catherine Newbit" then lists "my nine children" including another Catherine, aged less than 14.

Johann Philip MINK and Elizabeth (Prob) KALER had the following children:

A. Catherine (Keaty) MINK6,7 was born on 28 May 1770. She died on 29 Apr 1846. She was buried in Newbert Private Cem., N. Waldoboro, Lincoln, ME.

Johann Philip MINK was married to Anna Maria Susanna HOFFSES about 1772.8 Anna Maria Susanna HOFFSES9 was born on 16 Oct 1755. She died about 1820. Johann Philip MINK and Anna Maria Susanna HOFFSES had the following children:

B. Mary MINK10 was born in 1774.11 Shown on 1850 census living with family of Daniel Kaler. Mary's sister Catherine married him. (See p 4 Maxwell)

C. Magdalene MINK12,13 was born about 1775. She was listed in the home of Eben Mink in the 1860 census. She died between 1860 and 1870.

D. George MINK14,15,16 was born on 8 Aug 1778. He died on 9 Oct 1872. He was buried in Goshen Cem., East Waldoboro, Lincoln, ME. 1850 Census lists as age 72, farmer, \$1000.

E. Philip MINK17,18 was born on 1 Jan 1780.19 He died on 18 Aug 1859.20 Carpenter? Served in War 1812-14 in Capt. P Keizor's Co. Lieut. Col. S Thatcher's Regt from Sept 4, to Sept 10 1814. Raised at Waldoboro. Service at Camden. Listed as Private. Was living in Hope in 1850 census at age 70.

"Philip (This Philip b. 1780, was probably the father of Thomas Mink, the elder, of N. Waldoboro, and grandfather of Lizzie Walter Storer, who (at 85 years) remembers hearing that her grandfather Mink died leaving eight children, and her grandmother married again; does not remember her grandmother's name. I believe she was Margaret Benner, m. Philip Mink Feb. 26, 1802, (Waldoboro Records). Further, I believe he did not die but that they separated or she died and that he is the Philip Mink who married Rachel Flanders, Dec. 13, 1827, and was living in Hope, age 70, in 1850 (see Census).

The Ludwig Gen. states Margaret Burnheimer m. John Wallis, had a daughter Margaret who m. Philip Mink. She may have married a Benner first. Lizzie Storer's story may have reference to this - possibly Margaret died after her second marriage and Philip then married Rachel. (Esther Gross) "

F. Margret MINK21.

G. Elizabeth MINK22,23 was born about 1788. Possibly b. 1788, never married. (Hoffes)

H. John MINK24,25 was born about 1788. He died. On p 37 Hoffses says 20 Jan 1819 was death date but this was marriage date, according to Maxwell.

I. Sally (Sarah) MINK26. She never married.

J. Catherine MINK27. "A minor under 14 in 1807 (may have been the Catherine whose int. to Nathaniel Palmer of Salem Massachusetts were filed 12 Jul 1817

II. Valentine MINK28,29 was born in 1754. He died on 19 Jun 1832. He was buried in Goshen Cem., East Waldoboro, Lincoln, ME. Served in Revolutionary War under Capt Fuller in Col. Bond's Reg't, later served under Capt Smith's Co. in same reg't. Children are named.

Mary MINK(MRS)30 was born in 1781. She died on 16 Sep 1850. She was buried in Goshen Cem., East Waldoboro, Lincoln, ME. Valentine MINK and Mary MINK(MRS) had the following children:

A. Catherine MINK31.

B. Philip MINK32 was born in 1799.

C. Susan MINK33 was born in 1800.34,35 Two dates given on same page 1805 and 1800. Tombstone at burial site on Gross Neck, Waldoboro, Lincoln, ME on farm owned by Mel Gross says 1800-1869. She died in 1869.

D. Margaret MINK36 was born in 1807.

E. John MINK37 was born in 1808.

F. Godfrey MINK38 was born in 1812.

III. Paul MINK39,40 was born in Aug 1763 in Waldoboro, Lincoln, ME.41 He died on 7 Jul 1839 in Waldoboro, Lincoln, ME. Twin, served in the American Revolution. Listed in Pension Act of 1832 as age 81 from Lincoln County, having served in the Mass Mil. as a Private. Was a pvt in Capt Ulmer's Co. in Col Mcobb's Reg't 7 month 25 days. He lived in Waldoboro before being drafted and continued to live there until his death in 1839. Born in 1753 (which differs from Maxwell notes which say 1763).

Paul MINK and Mary Elizabeth GROSS had the following children:

A. Paul MINK Jr42 was born in 1785.43 Age at death is carved as 75y, that would make him born in 1789 rather than the year 1785 that is derived from census. He died on 15 Oct 1864. He was buried in Goshen Cem., East Waldoboro, Lincoln, ME. Listed on 1850 Waldoboro Census as laborer. Lived just over the town line in Friendship, it's thought he is buried in E. Friendship.

B. Peter Martin MINK44.

C. John MINK45.

D. Valentine MINK46 was born on 5 May 1778. He died on 15 Dec 1832. Son of Paul (by deed)

E. Charles Bonapart MINK47 was born in 1777. He died in 1873.

IV. John Charles MINK48,49 was born in Aug 1763.50 He was age 88 in 1850 census. He died on 6 Apr 1859.51 He was buried in Goshen Cem., East Waldoboro, Lincoln, ME. Twin. The births of the five children of John C. and Sophia are recorded in the Wal. Rec. Ludwig Genealogy states John C. d 1860, aged 100. (1850 Census) age 88 farmer, \$1800.

From Edith Mank's records -"He was born according to his pension record in 1764 and died according to Goshen Cemetery record Apr 6, 1859 ae. 95 y 8 m. Henry Mank was the first son and Joseph Mank b 27 Jan 1808 was the last."

Pvt. in Capt Baker, Col. McCobb's Maine Militia. Entered 1776 and discharged 1781 - Rev. War. Pvt in Capt Parker, Col Hunt's Mass Line - 14 months \$44 per month - 4 Mar 1831.

John Charles MINK was married to Sophia ORFF in Apr 1796 in Waldoboro, Lincoln, ME.52 Sophia ORFF53 was born in 1767.50 She died on 29 May 1818. She was buried in Goshen Cem., East Waldoboro, Lincoln, ME.54 John Charles MINK and Sophia ORFF had the following children:

A. Henry MINK55 was born on 30 Apr 1799.56 He died on 30 Apr 1885. Henry lived in the present John Flanders place, E. Waldoboro. He and Elizabeth separated, after raising this large family, and lived apart many years in later life. (1850 Census) farmer, age 52, \$1000

B. Elizabeth MINK57 was born on 1 Apr 1800 in Waldoboro, Lincoln, ME.58

C. Catherine MINK59 was born on 17 Jul 1803 in Waldoboro, Lincoln, ME. Listed as age 42 in 1850 census This disagrees with dob 7/17/1803 p 25 Maxwell. She was living with her father John C. Mink in 1850 census, listed as Catherine Orff

D. Thomas William MINK60 was born on 6 Jul 1806 in Waldoboro, Lincoln, ME.61 He died on 16 Nov 1875.

E. Joseph MINK62,63 was born on 27 Jan 1808 in Waldoboro, Lincoln, ME. He died on 7 Oct 1849. Not listed with wife and daughter in 1850 census. From Lincoln County Records, Wills1848-1861 Joseph bequeaths to wife Elizabeth payment of \$300Names only daughter Jane Feraline and father John C. Mink. Dated 17 Sept 1849 and filed 26 Oct 1849. He died in the epidemic.

John Charles MINK was married to Rhoda ELLIS on 20 Mar 1823. Rhoda ELLIS64 was born in 1780.65 She died on 28 Aug 1849.66 She was buried in Goshen Cem., East Waldoboro, Lincoln, ME. Of Union. Her name listed as Rhoda Alice on p 60 Maxwell

V. Peter MINK67 was born in Jun 1766. He died on 5 Jan 1857. (1850 Census) Farmer age 84 \$1500 - Birth date calculated from age at death. A different death date is listed on p 13. That is 7/5/1857.

Susanna STORER68,69 was born on 5 May 1775.70,71 p 39 Maxwell mentions Susanna, dau of Andrew was b Nov 21, 1789. This is in dispute with census. She died on 10 Dec 1858. Peter MINK and Susanna STORER had the following children:

A. Andrew MINK72 was born in 1796. Served in War 1812-14 in Capt. P Keizor's Co. Lieut. Col. S Thatcher's Regt from Sept 4, to Sept 10 1814. Raised at Waldoboro. Service at Camden. Listed as Private. May be the Andrew whose int. to Catherine Hoffses 9/22/1821; to Mary Wallace, dau. of John and Margaret, 9/2/1826.

B. Sarah T. (Sally) MINK73 was born on 18 Jan 1797. She died in 1861.

C. James MINK74 was born in 1800.75 Shown on 1850 census as farmer, \$1500, age 50.

D. George MINK76 was born on 19 Aug 1802. He died on 7 Sep 1855. The wills of both Peter Mink and his son George mention the latter's son Oscar, but not Austin. The above, from Easton, mentions Austin but no Oscar. Wilbert Mank knows of no Oscar in his father's family and does not think it was part of his father's name. Peter's will probated 5/26/1857; Susan's 5/31/1859. - p 25 Lily

E. Martin MINK77,78 was born on 5 Apr 1805. He died on 15 Jul 1888. He was buried in Goshen Cem., East Waldoboro, Lincoln, ME. (1850 Census) Age 45, Farmer, \$1000

F. Caroline MINK79,80 was born in 1800.

G. Clarissa MINK81,82 was born on 21 Sep 1811.83 She died on 31 Jan 1903. p 27, 60 Maxwell says 31 Jan 1903; p 39 says d 1899 or 1894 age 46 or 96. She was buried in Goshen Cem., East Waldoboro, Lincoln, ME.

H. Josiah MINK84 was born in 1817.85 He died on 26 Sep 1892 in Waldoboro, Lincoln, ME.86 Died from carcinoma of lower jaw.

Looking for any info for **Thomas W. Bowes,** born July 25, 1842, in Castine, Hancock County, ME.

We believe he had two sons by Honora Birmingham, (she was born in Ireland), Thomas William Bowes, born June 25, 1870, and Francis Thomas Bowes born September 25, 1871, both born in Boston, Suffolk County, MA.

Also, my great grandmother Bessie Marion White was the adopted daughter of Vinal Keene (himself adopted) of Lincoln Co., ME. She was adopted off a Michigan Objiwa Indian Reservation we believe. This is the subject of my research. Vinal was married to Sophronia Ash. Bessie first married Guv W. Jackson of Maine, before marrying John White in MA. Vinal himself had been adopted by Francis (b. 1/30/1802 d. 7/27/1881) and Jane (b. 7/2/1819) Keene. They seemed to have adopted also Elisha Hall (b. 5/18/1851), Chris Kennedy (b. 11/13/1856), and possibly had a son themselves. Francis (b. 1/1/1866). Vinal, a farmer, seems to have lived in Greenbush (with the Deering family), Somerville, and Washington, ME. Because of the proximity to the Indian Island Reservation, we always thought Bessie was adopted from Maine Indians (Penobscot). But there are many ties to Michigan, and the possibility of Objiwa/Chippewa tribal connections...

Vinal Keene (aka. Venal Keen) b. 8/10/1833, died 1919 Sophronia Ash Keene b 1850 died 1912 and we believe both are buried at Marr Cemetery in Washington, Knox County, ME. Vinal was mustered out under the name Venal to the Second Maine Infantry Company D., as a private during the Civil War. Bessie Marion Keene's first marriage was to Guy W. "Old Bristol & Nobleboro Vital Records" lists this William as William 4th. In 1846 he petitioned the House of Representatives of the State of Maine to have his name changed to William Miller Sproul. Could Miller have been his mother's maiden name? A **Hannah Miller married Alexander Sproul** Jan. 25, 1807. Did they have a son named William born in 1812? I am a "Johnnie-come-lately" in this **Vogler** genealogy research, only been doing it for one year, having picked up on notes my mom left me when she died in 1988. I was working back then and didn't have the time nor the interest for genealogy. (Boy, am I sorry now! I don't have my mom to ask the many questions, the answers to which would bring her vast notes into focus for me.) Elmers brothers and sisters were: Irvin Everand Hoffses, Clarinda C Hoffses, Calvin Nelson Hoffses, Adeline Francis Hoffses, Bernice May Hoffses, Olin Spear Hoffses, Delia Gertrude Hoffses, Elton Isaac Hoffses, Donald George Hoffses, and Ralph Herman Hoffses.

The parents of Isaac Herman Hoffses were John Boyd Hoffses (1833-1894) and Adeline Francis Burns (1841-1869): both buried in the Ole Burns Cemetery, Back Cove, South Waldoboro, Maine.

The parents of John Boyd Hoffses were John Hoffses (1792-1848) and Sally Genthner (1798-1848).
