Thomas Waterman Haupt and Elsa (Elcie) Pitcher had the following children:

1. Julia Ann m. Charles Storer and had Carrie, Walter, and Wilfred. Carrie was married to Edward Miller.

2. Bertha m. Oliver Pitcher (he was son of Jeremiah and Judith - Elsa's brother) Oliver's brother was Abner Pitcher who married Hannah Creamer (she was the daughter of Robert Creamer and Eliza Seiders). Hannah is also the sister of Mary Ann Creamer who was married to Hampton Haupt. Bertha and Oliver had Charles and Etta Pitcher.

3. Edwin died at age 9 in 1839.

4. Deborah m. Alexander Wiley and had Rogene (a daughter). Rogene married James Hale Castner and had Kenneth and Edith.

5. Hampton m. Mary Ann Creamer and had sons, Roenello and Charles.

6. Catherine Vesper m. Oliver Morse and had Geneva who married Wilber Wilson.

7. Thomas E. b and d in 1842.

8. Augusta Susan m. Boyd Winchenbach

9. Thomas E. b. 1848 d. 1883 and was married to Addie Pitcher.

10. Alice S. m. William Geyer

Elsa was the daughter of Abner Pitcher and Chloe Sweetland. Her brothers were Jeremiah m. Judith Farnsworth, Jesse m. Julia Haupt, John m. Lucinda Ludwig, James m. Catherine Vannah and her sisters, Nancy who married Oliver Morse and Catherine who was married to Peter Vesper. She also had a brother Samuel that I haven't traced.

The name Vesper comes from Peter (Captain Peter WESBERG) Vesper who was born in Sweden and came to Thomaston, Maine. He was married 2x - 1st to Catherine Pitcher who was a sister to Elcie (had Ambrose Franklin Vesper who married Margaret Black in England and had 3 children) and 2nd to Elmira Morse (they had 4 sons). Elmira was a sister to Oliver Morse who married Catherine Vesper Haupt (#6 above).
